## Volunteer Opportunity

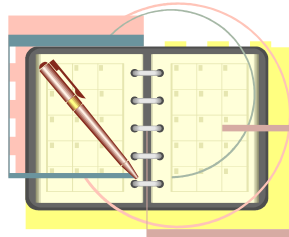
The Kingsport Boys and Girls club is looking for more after school activity ideas that might engage some of the older boys and girls. They are considering a photography club.
